## Benefits of Federation

We have already begun so see some very positive benefits of our federation through economies of scale for purchasing goods and services and for joint working for our administrative teams. Up and coming projects / work plans

In the coming year, the Governing Body has committed to reviewing and updating our Webpages. Moving forwards, Holly Moore will now become the Science Lead for the Federation, supported by the other staff.

We have also been working very hard to continue to develop our sports offer and are delighted that we have again been recognised for this through the Sports Games Mark awards.

The pupils and staff have worked incredibly hard this year and despite the recent changes in staffing and in governance, we are delighted with our End of Year Key Stage 2 results. For GDPR reasons, we are unable to publish the results due to the small cohorts involved. This is to protect the pupils concerned. However, the governors have reviewed all of the results in detail and would like to thank the pupils, staff and parents for all their hard work and excellent achievements.

We continue to be proud Local Authority Schools, working with advice and guidance of the local authority and its advisors.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all our parents and pupils for their continued support during this transitional year. We wish our departing parents and pupils the very best for the future and look forward to welcoming back our returning and arriving families.
